In June, we had 3 members out picking up litter on our Adopted Street, Woodlawn Dr. The City of Valdosta has placed a sign on both ends of Woodlawn Dr proclaiming it Adopted by the Azalea City Woman's Club.

Update on our symbolically adopted sea turtle, Frank Sriracha! "Frank Sriracha is thriving which is largely due to a clean and balanced environment. Keeping the water clean involves daily, weekly, and monthly tasks. We assess the salinity, ozone, temperature, and water clarity each day. Every week, we conduct a comprehensive water quality check, and tank filters are cleaned monthly. If we detect toxic levels of certain compounds such as ammonium or nitrite, we replace the tank water immediately. Our rehabilitation team will continue their hard work to ensure Frank Sriracha remains in peak health. Stay tuned for more updates on this little turtle!"
